7. Precast Concrete Catch Basins & Risers
8. Manhole Risers and Cast Iron Frames and Grates
9. Mulch Hay, Straw & Silt Fence
10. Bagged Concrete, Mortar Mix & Cement Block

Bids for said items shall be submitted in a sealed envelope at the above address. Envelopes shall bear on the face thereof the name and address of the bidder and be marked with the appropriate item(s) being bid upon.

Bids shall be on forms supplied by the Town and bids shall comply with the Specifications and Information for Bidders available to interested bidders at www.townofwallkill.com >Quick Links >Requests for Proposals/Bid Documents.

Contracts for the above items will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. Where bids are identical, the contract may be awarded to either bidder.

The Town Board reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all bids, and the prices submitted shall be exclusive of Federal and State Taxes.

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SPECIFICATION AND INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS
MULCH HAY, MULCH STRAW, & SILT FENCE
2018 HIGHWAY BIDS

1. Hay & Straw shall be small bales, wire or twine tied. Once cut must be stored dry prior to delivery. Mulch hay and straw shall meet the physical requirements of NYSDOT material designations 713-18 and 713-19, respectively.
2. Mulch hay - hay for mulching shall be mowing's of acceptable herbaceous growth which is free from noxious weeds. Materials which are low grade and unfit for farm use such as "U.S. sample grade." will be acceptable. Weight shall be calculated on the basis of the material having not more than 15% of moisture content.
3. Straw – Straw for mulching shall be stalks of oats, wheat, rye or other approved crops which are free from noxious weeds. Materials which are low grade and unfit for firm use, use such as "U.S. sample grade." will be acceptable. Weight shall be calculated on the basis of the material having not more than 15% of moisture content.
4. Silt Fence – Shall be pre-assembled to posts, and consist of woven mesh or wire reinforced woven mesh. 100 foot rolls are preferred. Please state brand and weight.
