PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that sealed bids will be received at the Office of the Town Clerk, Town of Wallkill, Town Hall, 99 Tower Drive, Building A, Middletown, New York 10941 until 10:00am on the 13th day of November, 2018 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following items:

5. Precast Concrete Catch Basins & Risers
6. Manhole Risers and Cast Iron Frames and Grates
7. Bagged Concrete, Mortar Mix & Cement Block

Bids for said items shall be submitted in a sealed envelope at the above address. Envelopes shall bear on the face thereof the name and address of the bidder and be marked with the appropriate item(s) being bid upon.

Bids shall be on forms supplied by the Town and bids shall comply with the Specifications and Information for Bidders available to interested bidders at www.townofwallkill.com >Quick Links >Requests for Proposals/Bid Documents.

Contracts for the above items will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. Where bids are identical, the contract may be awarded to either bidder.

The Town Board reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all bids, and the prices submitted shall be exclusive of Federal and State Taxes.

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SPECIFICATION AND INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS
GUIDERAIL MATERIALS
2019 HIGHWAY BIDS

General:

1. All prices quoted shall be guaranteed and in effect for the entire 2019 and 2020 calendar years.
2. It is the Town's current intent to spend approximately \$15,000.00 on guide rail materials and post pounding in 2019 and an equivalent amount in 2020, if appropriated in the 2020 budget. No guarantee is made, though, of the actual amounts to be spent.
3. It is further the Town's intent to hire this contractor to pound the posts required in each area, and to furnish and deliver all of the other components required to complete each location for installation by the Town's own forces.
4. Guiderail bidders must be able to furnish all materials and maintain sufficient stock so that guiderail materials will be delivered within ten (10) calendar days after receipt of order.
5. All materials must be provided and installation must be performed in accordance with New York State Department of Transportation specifications.
6. Bidders must bid on all items or bid will be rejected.

Guiderail, Posts, and Accessories:

1. All materials must be furnished new and not used unless specifically noted as "used" on the Bid Proposal form.
2. Guide rail materials shall meet NYSDOT galvanizing specifications.
3. All materials to conform to NYSDOT specifications Section 606 and Standard sheet 606.6-12 gauge and 606-3R1-12 gauge.
