WHEREAS, in accordance with New York State Town Law Article 12-A, the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill, County of Orange, State of New York wishes to consider the formation of the Arfman Sewer District in the Town of Wallkill bounded and described in a Map, Plan and Report dated April 2, 2018 prepared by Pitingaro & Doetsch Consulting Engineers, P.C.; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Arfman Sewer District shall provide sewage treatment services to the properties bounded and described in the aforesaid Map, Plan and Report as described and now on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town, and

WHEREAS, the sewage treatment services and facilities to be utilized within the proposed district to be formed are already in place and the cost of any new connections to such facilities shall be borne solely by the property owner(s) within said district seeking same, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the connection fee to any incoming parcels is a minimum of \$2,300.00 for residential connections and with respect to non-residential purposes, the connections fee will be determined by the City of Middletown Treasurer and Commission of Public Works based upon estimated consumption; and there will be no past debt service fee, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board is the sole Involved Agency in connection with the formation of the Arfman Sewer District, the Town Board preliminarily classifies this action as "Unlisted" in accordance with the SEQRA regulations and intends to prepare a Short Environmental Assessment Form in connection with the district formation, .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that on the 24th day of May, 2018 at 7:25 o'clock P.M. on said day, the Town Board will meet and hold a public hearing to consider the formation of the Arfman Sewer District, including the environmental significance thereof, and to hear all persons interested in the subject therefore, and for such other and further action on the part of the Town Board in connection with this matter as may be appropriate, and be it

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL PURSUANT TO TOWN CODE §249-26.2(C)(13) and (14) IN SUPPORT OF THE APPLICATION OF HOLIDAY LAKE LLC TO APPLY TO THE TOWN PLANING BOARD FOR A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A WAREHOUSE/MANUFACTURING FACILITY ON SULLIVAN LANE WITHIN THE TOWN

WHEREAS, Holiday Lake LLC is interested in applying to the Town Planning Board to construct and operate a warehouse/manufacturing facility within the Town of Wallkill (the “Project”) on a 46 acre parcel of land located in the Office and Research (OR) District of the Town on Sullivan Lane known as Tax Map # 60-1-41 (the “Project Site”); and

WHEREAS, the development of a warehouse/manufacturing facility in the OR District of the Town is a special permit use which must be approved by the Town Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Town Code §249-26.2(C)(13) and (14), as a condition precedent to filing a special use permit application with the Town Planning Board, the applicant must obtain a resolution supporting the proposed use from the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board does not object to the proposed Project or the development of same at the Project Site and supports said Project; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the Town Board’s support, the Project must comply with the local planning, zoning and relevant environmental review processes for any required approvals in order to ensure the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the community; and

WHEREAS, the support of the Town Board is conditioned upon each of the criteria set forth below being agreed to and carried out by Holiday Lake LLC,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill supports the application to be filed by Holiday Lake LLC with the Town Planning Board to construct and operate a warehouse/manufacturing facility within the Town of Wallkill on a 46 acre parcel of land located in the Office and Research (OR) District of the Town on Sullivan Lane known as Tax Map # 60-1-41, subject to the following conditions, with a copy of this Resolution to be submitted as an exhibit to the Planning Board Special Use Permit Application:

- The proposed facility shall be limited to a maximum square footage of 322,560 to be constructed consistent with the rendering prepared by Lanc & Tully Engineering and Surveying, P.C. dated March 12, 2018;
- The only use of the Project Site shall be solely warehouse/manufacturing or any other permitted use within the OR District;
- Holiday Lake LLC shall pay all fees incurred by the Town for professional services rendered in connection with this Project, including, but not limited to, legal fees and engineering consultant fees. Such fees will be paid pursuant to a Developer's Escrow Agreement between the Town and Holiday Lake LLC;
- All legal restrictions and zoning laws relevant to the property depicted in the Lanc & Tully rendering in effect at the time that the special use permit application is submitted to the Town Planning Board shall control any future development of the Project Site whether such laws and restrictions are reduced in any fashion.
- In the event that the special use permit application is denied by Town Planning Board for any reason, this resolution shall become null and void upon such denial; and is further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Chairman of the Town of Wallkill Planning Board.
