**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL GRANTING
A TAX EXEMPTION TO CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF
MIDDLETOWN WITHIN THE TOWN OF WALLKILL**

WHEREAS, the City of Middletown ("Middletown"), by deed dated December 18, 2019, acquired certain real property from the State of New York ("State") located within the Town of Wallkill known as 393 County Route 78, Tax Map No. 69-1-64.66 ("the Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Property is currently exempt from Town real property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the deed conveying the Property to Middletown from the State contains a restriction that said Property may only be used by Middletown for park and recreational uses or it shall revert back to the State; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested that the Town Board grant continued tax-exempt status to the Property and the Town Board is willing to grant said request,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill hereby authorizes the Town Assessor to grant continued tax-exempt status to the real property located within the Town of Wallkill known as 393 County Route 78, Tax Map No. 69-1-64.66, effective as of January 1, 2020 and to take all steps necessary to classify the property as such effective for the taxable status date of March 1, 2020.
