EXTENSION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

The Town of Wallkill State of Emergency Declaration issued by the undersigned on March 12, 2020 with respect to the outbreak of the novel coronavirus, COVID-19 is hereby extended as set forth herein.

This extension has been ordered due to the need for continued action on the part of the Town of Wallkill by mobilizing resources and taking all steps necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.

In addition to the contents of the original State of Emergency Declaration dated March 12, 2020, all of which remain in effect, the Town strongly recommends to all residents and businesses to observe the following guidelines of conduct to the extent practical:

1. Residents should utilize online and telephone ordering services for the purchase of goods and services whenever those options are available.
2. There should be maximum use of delivery services and curbside pickup.
3. Businesses that have been permitted to continue operations pursuant to the latest order of the Governor of the State of New York must adhere to the state mandated maximum limitation of 50 persons in their establishments.
4. Continue to practice the protocols of "social distancing," which is generally regarded as a 6-foot buffer with other people.

The Wallkill Town Hall will remain open and operational absent further notice. All in-person services which are provided to residents at Town Hall shall be by appointment only. Residents are directed to call the Town's main switchboard number at (845) 692-7800 and follow the prompts for routing to the desired department. Prior to calling, please log on to www.townofwallkill.com as many services offered in person are available online. The Town of Wallkill Police Department will continue with normal operations and those wishing to go to the Police Department for any reason may continue to do so.

As the Chief Executive of the Town of Wallkill, I, Frank DenDanto III, exercise the authority vested to me under the provisions of Article 2-B of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of the Town. I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the Town of Wallkill to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and provide such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
