Dear Town of Wallkill Residents:

On July 4, 2013 the Town of Wallkill will be holding their 11th Annual fireworks display at the Town of Wallkill Golf Course, which is located on Sands Road. Due to the expected increase in traffic in the area, at approximately 6:00pm on July 4, 2013, Sands Road will become a one-way street. Vehicles will only be able to enter Sands Road from Route 17M and exit Sands Road onto Goshen Turnpike. There will be no parking on Sands Road during this event and any vehicles parked on the roadway after 6:00pm will be towed. It is anticipated that Sands Road will be reopened to two-way traffic at approximately 11:45pm on July 4th, 2013. In order to expedite the flow of traffic, the only exception to the one way restriction on Sands Road, will be the bus traffic. Buses will be allowed to travel in both directions during the entire event, as they will be shuttling visitors from designated parking areas.

In addition, I would like to point out that as of 6:00pm only traffic being allowed onto Sands Road will be official vehicles, buses, and residents of the affected area. In order to avoid any inconvenience it is highly recommended that if you plan on returning to your residence during the event; you carry a picture identification card with you, such as your driver's license. The identification card should indicate your address on it.

I would like to thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
